

## Getting to Heriot-Watt University's Edinburgh Campus

### Airport

Heriot-Watt is a 10-15 minute taxi journey from Edinburgh Airport. This will cost around £12.

### Train

Get the train to **Haymarket** or **Edinburgh Waverley** (Haymarket is slightly closer to Heriot-Watt).

Taxis are available at Haymarket and Edinburgh Waverley. A taxi to Heriot-Watt will take 20-30 mins and cost around £20.

Frequent buses connect Haymarket and Edinburgh Waverley stations to Heriot-Watt. These cost £1.50, but will take 35-50 mins.

Do **not** travel to Edinburgh Park or Curriehill stations – these stations do not have public transport links.

### Bus

The number 25 bus connects Heriot-Watt with the city centre and Haymarket. These buses are at least every 10 minutes. The bus costs a flat fare of £1.50 (exact change only).

Bus from Edinburgh Waverley station/Princes Street: Leave Waverley station via the Princes Street exit (“Waverley Steps”). At the top of Waverley Steps turn left. The bus stop is close by, on the same side of the road as the station - catch the 25 to Riccarton.

Bus from Haymarket station: Turn right at the station exit. Walk along the pavement, passing a Starbucks on your right. Keep walking straight ahead and cross the main road (Dalry Road) at the lights. After crossing the road, turn right. Catch the 25 to Riccarton from the first bus stop on this road.

Where to get off the bus: Heriot-Watt is the last stop on the 25 Riccarton route. Towards the end of the journey the bus will go through a Park & Ride car park, and then turn into the Heriot-Watt campus. It will finish the route at a large roundabout - this stop is at the Heriot-Watt main reception <http://www.hw.ac.uk/timetable/docs/Edinburgh/edinctrmap.pdf> .

### Driving

Visitors' parking is in Car Parks A and B. You do not need a permit.
